Mobile Meals is a non-profit organization that has provided nutritional meals to elderly, disabled, and homebound individuals 7 days a week, 365 days a year, for over 40 years.

Currently we have several different routes serving the city of La Crosse. All of the meals are delivered by volunteers.

Each route has a maximum of 16 deliveries. Depending on the size of the route, the delivery time can take anywhere from 45 minutes to 1.5 hours. Pick up time is at 11 a.m.

Our two pick up locations are at Mayo Clinic Health System on Market Street in La Crosse and Bethany On Cass located on Cass Street in La Crosse.

Participants may order one or two meals per day. In either case the delivery occurs around noon hour. The one meal plan includes a hot meal with milk, and the two meal plan includes the hot meal as well as milk, a sandwich and dessert.

1. Participation in the program may be obtained by client's own personal application, or by referral from his/her physician, pastor, family member or a social service agency.
2. This service is provided according to need. It is intended primarily for individuals who are unable to shop and/or cook for themselves.
3. We do not discriminate against anyone with respect to race, religion, orientation, ethnicity or income level.
4. Each applicant will be evaluated for eligibility by an appointed person of the sponsoring agency or by the Mobile Meals Coordinator. There will be a periodic evaluation of these needs with the referral agency.
5. The applicant must be under the care of a physician if a special diet is required. The physician will be contacted as needed.
6. The applicant must reside within the boundaries of the city limits of La Crosse.
7. 24 hour notice is required to be considered for Mobile Meals delivery. Applicant may be placed on a waiting list pending availability of meal delivery routes.
8. Meal service may not be changed through the delivery driver. Please call (608) 784-4623 during Mobile Meals office hours between 8 a.m. and 2 p.m. for schedule changes or cancellations.

Meals are picked up by volunteer drivers and delivered between 11:00 am and 1:00 pm including weekends and holidays.
